NEWS

SPRINGFIELD – The Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation took the following disciplinary actions:

The Director of the Division of Insurance, Michael T. McRaith, signed the following disciplinary actions during the months of **April and May 2007**:

Kenneth Lopretta, Wentzville – insurance producer license revoked effective April 20, 2007. Mr. Lopretta had been licensed to sell life, accident, health, fire, and casualty insurance since 1991. His license was revoked as a result of an investigation, which revealed that the Licensee was involved in the sale of thirty-two insurance policies through an authorized insurer.

Kirkwood Insurance Service, St. Louis, MO & Richard Kalina, Richmond Heights, MO – insurance producer license revoked effective April 20, 2007. Kirkwood Insurance Service and Richard Kalina had been licensed since 1996 and 1983 respectively, to sell life, accident, and health insurance. The licenses were revoked as a result of an investigation, which revealed that the Business Entity and Licensee were involved in the sale of forty-four insurance policies through an authorized insurer.

John L. Alexander, Chicago – insurance producer license application denied effective May 4, 2007. Mr. Alexander was applying for a Limited Lines Representative insurance license which was denied as a result of an investigation, which revealed that he submitted numerous dishonest checks to the Division and failed to replace them.

Lavera Turentine, Chicago – insurance producer license revoked effective May 4, 2007. Ms. Turentine had been licensed to sell life, accident, health, property and casualty insurance since August 15, 2000. Her license was revoked as a result of an investigation, which revealed felony convictions of Retail Theft in 1992 and Possession of a Controlled Substance in 1994. Furthermore, she failed to reveal the felonies to the Division.

The Director of the Division of Professional Regulation, Daniel E. Bluthardt, signed the following disciplinary actions taken during the month of May **2007**:

APPRAISAL

Pedro Roman – Chicago - the certified general appraiser license was reprimanded and extra education was required for, *inter alia*, violating a provision or standard for the development or communication of an appraisal.

Dustin Banks – Hammond, Ind. – the associate appraiser license was suspended for 90 days and a \$1,000.00 fine was assessed for, *inter alia*, failing to produce records on request

Mark Vanwagenen – Elgin – the associate appraiser license was reprimanded and a \$2,500.00 was assessed for failing to insure that a certified appraiser signed off on reports before the appraiser-employer sent the reports to the client; it was further agreed that the application for the certified residential appraiser license be granted.

Gregory Darling – Evanston – the certified residential appraiser license was reprimanded and a \$1,500.00 fine was assessed for failing to produce documents upon request and for failing to properly verify the experience requirement for the license.

James Barber – Chicago – the certified residential appraiser license was indefinitely suspended for a minimum period of 2 years for, *inter alia*, failing to provide sufficient information in an appraisal report for the intended user to adequately understand the rationale for the opinions and conclusions.

Walter Jackson – Chicago – the certified residential appraiser license was revoked based upon a felony conviction.

Cynthia Falkenberg – Bloomingdale – the associate appraiser license was revoked for attempting to obtain a license with false information and for using the identity of another appraiser on appraisal reports.

Terrance Williams – Chicago – the associate appraiser license was revoked for intentionally misrepresenting that another appraiser was significantly involved in contributing to appraisal reports.
