Springfield, Illinois, January 2000 -- Leonard A. Sherman, Director of the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation, announced the following disciplinary actions taken by the Department for the month of **December 1999**.

ACCOUNTANT

The following were ordered to cease and desist the unlicensed practice of public accounting:

COSMETOLOGY

Jenny L. Koser, Walnut – cosmetologist license indefinitely suspended for failing to submit proof of required continuing education hours.

Ivy A. Neely, Chicago – cosmetologist license placed on indefinite probation after defaulting on an Illinois Student Assistance loan.

Kimberly Raickett, Chicago – cosmetologist license indefinitely suspended for failing to comply with the terms and conditions of a previously ordered probation.

Valerie K. Boyd Thomas, Springfield – cosmetologist license reprimanded and fined \$150 for aiding and abetting the unlicensed practice of cosmetology at her salon.

Rofdel Unisex, Chicago – salon license reprimanded and fined \$750 for permitting two unlicensed individuals to practice cosmetology at the salon.

Maritza Zavala, Chicago – cosmetologist license placed on indefinite probation for failing to submit proof of required continuing education hours.

DETECTIVE, ALARM, SECURITY AND LOCKSMITH

Glenn Carter, Chicago – permanent employee registration card placed on probation for three years due to criminal conviction.

Billy Gene Seals, Chicago – permanent employee registration card restored to indefinite probation.

David Brown, Chicago – permanent employee registration card application denied and may no longer practice under the provisions of the Private Detective, Private Alarm, Private Security and Locksmith Act of 1993.

LAND SURVEYING

Mid America Survey Co., Waukegan and David N. Mann, Waukegan – professional land surveyor design firm license of Mid America Survey Co. placed on probation for 18 months and fined \$10,000 for allegedly operating branch offices of its professional design firm without having a resident registered professional land surveyor overseeing the land surveying practices in each location. David N. Mann's land surveyor license suspended for one month followed by probation for 17 months and fined \$10,000 for allegedly aiding Mid-America in operating the branch offices.

MEDICAL

Robert A. Hess, Glenview – physician and surgeon license indefinitely suspended for failing to fully pay Illinois income taxes for 1992 and failing to file Illinois income tax returns from 1995 to 1998.

Prakash Khot, King, NC – physician and surgeon license indefinitely suspended after being disciplined in North Carolina.

Rashidah Malik, Aurora – physician and surgeon license indefinitely suspended for failing to file Illinois income tax returns from 1992 to 1998.

Calvin Williams, Chicago – physician and surgeon license indefinitely suspended for failing to comply with the terms and conditions of a previously ordered probation.

NAIL TECHNOLOGY

Emily Tran d/ba/ L.A. Nails, Galesburg – salon license placed on probation for four years and fined \$1,000 for allowing unlicensed practice of nail technology at the salon.

NURSING

Lynn Baker, Galesburg – licensed practical nurse license reprimanded and fined \$1,700 for working as a nurse for more than two years without a license and failing to accurately complete her nursing license application by failing to disclose her employment in nursing.

Linda D. Blunt, Granite City – registered nurse license placed on indefinite probation after defaulting on an Illinois Student Assistance loan.

James Coffee, River Grove – registered nurse license indefinitely suspended for diverting Meperidine from his employer.

Sarah Eddy, Beloit, WI – registered nurse license placed on probation for three years for diverting controlled substances while employed at Swedish Covenant Hospital, theft and use of Dilaudid after entering an Employee Assistance Program and use of crack cocaine subsequent to her termination.

Patricia A. Forbes, Chicago – licensed practical nurse license restored to probation for three years.

Laura Holliman, Springfield – licensed practical nurse license indefinitely suspended for failing to respond to patient needs in two separate incidents.

Susan R. Holman, Westchester – registered nurse license indefinitely suspended for failing to comply with the terms and conditions of a previously ordered probation.

Reta Hur, Chicago – registered nurse license indefinitely suspended for failing to file Illinois income tax returns from 1994 to 1996 and failing to pay income taxes from 1990 to 1993.

David Kingry, Ooltewah, TN – registered nurse license placed on indefinite probation after being disciplined in Mississippi and Tennessee.

Marla Reynolds, Decatur – licensed practical nurse license suspended for 60 days followed by probation for two years after testing positive for morphine and codeine on a random drug screen.

William L. Wallenda, Chicago – registered nurse license restored to probation for two years.

OPTOMETRY

Chong Cha Hart, Decatur – ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,000 for the unlicensed practice of optometry by unlawfully selling contact lenses through Hair Wonder Beauty Supply.

PHARMACY

Mary Eberle, Canton – pharmacist license reprimanded and fined \$400 for allowing an employee who was not licensed as a pharmacy technician to assist in the practice of pharmacy prior to the application being submitted to the Department.

Judith Eileen Kelm, Lockport – pharmacy technician license placed in refuse to renew status after diverting controlled substances from her employer.

Wal-Mart Stores Inc. d/b/a Wal-Mart Pharmacy 10-1713, Canton – pharmacy license reprimanded for allowing an employee who was not licensed as a pharmacy technician to assist in the practice of pharmacy prior to the application being submitted to the Department.

PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS

Samuel J. Miller, Elwood – professional counselor license indefinitely suspended after engaging in a sexual relationship with a patient beginning the day he terminated his therapeutic relationship with the patient, and failing to maintain billing and clinical records for services rendered to that patient and her child. Miller also bartered his professional services for another patient in exchange for electrical services without a proper written agreement.

ROOFING CONTRACTORS

Alva W. Miner, Joliet – ordered to cease and desist the unlicensed practice as a roofing contractor.
