ATHLETIC TRAINING

Show Me Productions, John Walter Harris, Florissant, MO – athletics license (002-163025) ordered to cease and desist the unlicensed practice as a boxing promoter.

BARBER, COSMETOLOGY, ESTHETICS AND NAIL TECHNOLOGY

Nancy Garcia, Chicago – cosmetologist license (011app227416) issued with indefinite suspension for a minimum of six months due to a felony conviction.

Teri Thomas, Chicago – cosmetologist license (011app226941) issued and placed on indefinite probation for a minimum of five years due to a felony conviction.

FUNERAL DIRECTORS & EMBALMERS

Timothy M. Harrington, Chicago – funeral director and embalmer license (034-014478) was reprimanded and fined \$2,000 for practicing on a non-renewed license.

E. Robert Pape III, Danville – funeral director and embalmer license (034-010615) was reprimanded and fined \$500 due to unprofessional conduct.

MEDICAL

Imtiaz Ahmad, Christopher – physician and surgeon license (036-088461) and controlled substance license (336-050297) placed in refuse to renew status for being more than 30 days delinquent in the payment of child support.
