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Springfield, IL, July 1999 -- Leonard A. Sherman, Director of the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation, announced the following disciplinary actions taken by the Department for the month of **June 1999**.

ACCOUNTANT

Michael J. Whalen, Buffalo Grove -- public accountant license indefinitely suspended for failing to submit proof of required continuing education hours.
