MEDICAL

P. Kevin Barkal, San Diego, CA – physician and surgeon license reprimanded and fined \$2,500 for violating a previously ordered probation by not sending written proof of his compliance with the terms of his California probation.

David P. Calimag, Morton Grove – physician and surgeon license reprimanded and fined \$3,000 for allegedly providing treatment to persons who were participants in fraudulent personal injury claims and who had no injuries.

Robert Foresman, Casey – physician and surgeon license suspended pending a hearing before the Illinois Medical Disciplinary Board after a mental evaluation revealed he suffers from a psychological disorder and alcohol dependence which affect his ability to practice medicine.

NURSING

Berry, Paris – registered nurse license indefinitely suspended for ordering a certified nurse assistant to remove a wheelchair from a residents room, ordering staff to restrain a resident without physicians orders to do so and instructing two assistants to ignore the call light of a resident.

Cheryl Broady, Villa Grove – registered nurse license placed on probation for three years for diverting controlled substances from her employer.

Shanda Edwards, Rock Island – licensed practical nurse license placed on probation for two years due to a felony conviction for residential burglary and aggravated battery.

Karen L. Hicks, Decatur – registered nurse license placed on probation for one year and fined \$1,000 for engaging in irregular billing practices when she submitted claims to her employer for nursing services involving a home health patient.
