ACPE Update	<p>Mr. Manek welcomed Mike Rouse, ACPE to the meeting.</p> <p>Mr. Rouse thanked the Board for having him at the meeting.</p> <p>Mr. Rouse explained that the new professional development is not necessarily endorsed by ACPE.</p> <p>Mr. Rouse explained the need for Continuing Professional Development (CE) to the Board.</p> <p>He Explained the ups and downs of the current CE as it can lead to passive learners. The educational systems do not adequately address a number of issues that are of concerns of the pharmacist.</p> <p>Mr. Rouse reviewed and explained what he felt were problems and possible solutions. He feels that we can look to other professions and countries for the answers to the problems that he feels that exist in continuing education.</p>	

	<p>Mr. Rouse discussed and explained several myths surrounding educational continuing education. Continuing Professional Development does not replace CE. Mr. Rouse feels that CPD is a new approach to helping pharmacists. New models are not saying pharmacist is dumb they are to help and assist pharmacist in their professional growth.</p> <p>Mr. Rouse welcomed any questions from the Board. Mr. Khatau asked about the pilot programs and they went. Mr. Rouse explained how they went.</p> <p>Mr. Anselmo asked about the portfolio used by students and how it worked. Mr. Rouse explained the objectives and goals of the program. Mr. Rouse further stated that they are working closely with NABP.</p> <p>Mr. Burgess asked how North Carolina implemented the CPD goals and acceptance into their Act and Rules. SB2060 was not listed due to the fact that it died last year.
