Motion was made, seconded (Parker/Cain) as follows 1) that a civil penalty in amount of \$5000 be imposed against Steve Douglas which shall be paid 60 days after date of order 2) that Steve Douglas be ordered to Cease and Desist from engaging in the unlicensed practice of barbering until he is licensed to do so and 3) that shop license 189-010097 be Revoked. Motion carried.

Board recommended that (2) applications be deferred pending receipt of three years legal practice as barber in another jurisdiction and that applicants be approved for barber examination based upon training/experience in other jurisdiction. (Action Sheets 091213-091214).

Cosmetologist Endorsement

Board recommended that (1) application be denied based upon training/experience in other jurisdiction and that applicant be approved for esthetician examination based upon training/experience in other jurisdiction (Action Sheet 091216).

Board recommended that (3) applications be denied based upon training/experience in other jurisdiction and that applicants be approved for cosmetologist examination based upon training/experience in other jurisdiction (Action Sheets 091217-091219).

Board recommended that (3) applications be deferred pending receipt of three years legal practice as cosmetologist in another jurisdiction and that applicants be approved for cosmetologist examination based upon training/experience in other jurisdiction (Action Sheets 091220-091222).

Continuing Education Sponsor

Board recommended that (4) applications be approved (Action Sheets 091223-091226).

Board recommended that (1) licensed sponsor be approved to provide continuing education courses to cosmetology teachers (Action Sheet 091227).

Board recommended that (1) application be deferred pending receipt of biographical information receipt of biographical information for instructor that does not include references to "Medical Esthetician" (Action Sheet 091228).

*NOTE: Estheticians who work for a physician perform duties as the physician's employee and not under their esthetician license. An individual working for a physician may not hold himself or herself out to be an esthetician.

Out-Of-State Continuing Education Approval

Board recommended that (1) application be denied because the subject areas fall outside the scope of practice for a licensed esthetician in Illinois (Action Sheet 091229).
