Chairman Time:

Mr. Sampognaro stated that the Department should consider having all applicants from a foreign jurisdiction complete the Illinois exam to receive a license. He indicated that other states require foreign trained applicants to complete the state exam and that Illinois should consider this to make the licensing process more consistent. Discussion was held regarding this matter.

Mr. Robertson stated that there is a degree of difficulty for the Department to evaluate programs completed in a foreign country. The transcript may only provide subject names and no description making it unclear what subject matter was covered.

NOTE: In these cases, the Department would request a course syllabus from the school; however, this information is not always available or provided. In that case, the Board could review the application and/or request the applicant to appear for an interview to determine the applicant's qualifications.

Rules Discussion

Mr. Thompson stated that the Board should take a look at the sections of the rules regarding salon registration, sanitary standards, and curriculum requirements. He further stated that the Department welcomes the input of the Board on any other section in the rules that may need revised or added.

Board members discussed the possible need to reduce the number of esthetics machines required for school operations. It was suggested that every work station should have 1 set of facial equipment that includes a steamer, mag lamp and woods lamp. In addition, the curriculum should including training in the use of the following equipment: brushing, vacuum/spray machine, glass electrode or high frequency current and disencrustation machine. However; no formal recommendation was made.

Board members who wish to provide written suggestions regarding rules language will submit the information in writing to Mr. Robertson.
