

“Grandfather” Continuing Education Exemption Repealed
Notice to All Real Estate Salespersons and Brokers

Pursuant to Public Act 93-0957, anyone licensed for 15 years prior to January 1, 1992 is no longer exempt from continuing education. Effective August 19, 2004, salespersons wishing to renew their license April 30, 2005 are required to complete six (6) hours of continuing education during the pre-renewal period; of which at least three (3) hours must be completed in the core curriculum. Previously exempted brokers will need to complete 12 hours of CE in the two years prior to the April 30, 2006 renewal date; of which at least six (6) hours must be completed in the core curriculum.
