### CHANGE IN EXPIRATION DATE FOR SALESPERSON LICENSES

Please note that due to a change in the Illinois Real Estate License Act of 2000, 225 ILCS 454/5-50(a), the expiration date for active real estate salesperson licenses is now **April 30, 2012**. Salespersons will not receive a new license unless one is purchased from the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation (IDFPR). **However, current licenses and pocket cards with the expiration date of 4/30/2011 are acceptable and can be used until 4/30/2012.**

If a salesperson would like a license that reflects the 4/30/2012 expiration date, please submit a written request. The fee for a new license is \$25; payment must be in the form of a check or money order made payable to IDFPR.

After April 30, 2011, salesperson licensees may wish to carry a copy of this notice with their pocket card should any questions arise regarding the validity of their license. In addition, real estate offices may want to post this notice with the original salesperson licenses kept at each office to avoid confusion regarding the expiration date.
