Springfield, Illinois – Fernando E. Grillo, Director of the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation, announced the following disciplinary actions taken by the Department during the month of **October 2003**.

ACCOUNTANT

Steven K. Kelly, Charleston – ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$12,750 for issuing audit opinions on the financial statements of a not-for-profit corporation without a public accountant license and for holding himself out as a public accountant.

Edward G. Maier, Chicago – public accountant license (065-023150) suspended after being denied the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) as an accountant based on Maier's actions while he was the Chicago office risk management partner and concurring partner for audits of financial statements of Waste Management, Inc. by Arthur Anderson, LLC. The suspension will run concurrently with the SEC action.

ARCHITECTS, LAND SURVEYORS, PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND STRUCTURAL ENGINEERS

Jack Louis Norman, Columbia – land surveyor license (035-001638) revoked and fined \$5,000 for practicing on a non-renewed license.
