Springfield, Illinois – Fernando E. Grillo, Director of the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation, announced the following disciplinary actions taken by the Department during the month of **May 2004**.

BARBER, COSMETOLOGY, ESTHETICS AND NAIL TECHNOLOGY

Karen Elliott, Chicago – cosmetologist license (011-223746) restored and placed on probation for two years.

DENTAL

Deepak Agarwal, Skokie – dentist license (019-025771) placed on probation for one year for providing substandard care to a patient, failing to properly maintain a patient record, aiding and abetting the unlicensed practice of dentistry, unlawfully lending the use of his dental license to another, seeking to obtain money by fraudulent means, and making false reports.

Iris Orozco a/k/a Iris Cervantes, Aurora – ordered to cease and desist the unlicensed practice of dentistry and pay a civil penalty of \$5,000.

David Weber, Willowbrook – dentist license (019-018607) placed on probation for two years and fined \$3,000 for billing for services not rendered.
