**ARCHITECTS, LAND SURVEYORS, PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS

Mila Reyngold, Design-N-Architecture, and DNA Inc., Lisle – ordered to cease and desist the unlicensed practice of architecture.

Gerald Schmitt, St. Joseph, MO – professional engineer license (062-035524) reprimanded and fined \$2,000 for affixing his professional engineer's seal to plans that required an architect or structural engineer seal.
