DENTAL

Stanley Caradine, Riverdale – dentist license (019-021871) placed on probation for 18 months, and controlled substance license suspended for 18 months and fined \$4,000, for dispensing controlled substances to two former employees for non-therapeutic uses, failing to keep proper records of the purchase and dispensing of controlled substances, and practicing beyond the scope of his dental license.

Thomas J. Musur, Vernon Hills – dentist license (019-021332) suspended retroactive to Dec. 10, 2001 through Jan. 25, 2002, followed by indefinite probation for failing to maintain proper sanitation standards and infection control.

Kenneth Ryback, Des Plaines – dentist (019-019960) and controlled substance licenses placed on probation for one year and fined \$1,000 for making unusually large purchases of Hydrocodone, non-therapeutically prescribing Vicodin to three patients, and failing to maintain controlled substance dispensing and prescribing logs.

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH PRACTITIONER

Barbara J. Sherrod, Chicago – environmental health practitioner license (183-000612) placed in refuse to renew status after defaulting on an Illinois Student Assistance loan.

MEDICAL
