Springfield, Illinois – Leonard A. Sherman, Director of the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation, announced the following disciplinary actions taken by the Department during the month of **March 2002**.

**ARCHITECTS, LAND SURVEYORS, PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS
AND STRUCTURAL ENGINEERS**

Atif Galal Ahmed, Peoria – professional engineer license (062-054402) temporarily suspended pending proceedings before the State Board of Professional Engineers for allegedly obtaining his professional engineer's license based upon false statements made on his application for licensure pertaining to his education and experience.

David C. Dallas, Mount Carmel – professional engineer license (062-034444) reprimanded and fined \$1,000 for practicing on a non-renewed license for approximately four years.

MEDICAL

Arden Barnett, Naperville – physician and surgeon license (036-072114) reprimanded for allegedly failing to transfer medical records in a timely fashion.

Luis D'Avis, Skokie – physician and surgeon license (036-056058) restored and placed on indefinite probation.

Virendra Desai, Chicago – physician and surgeon license (036-044107) reprimanded for failing to accurately ascertain the identity of two patients prior to administering anesthesia and fined \$500 for failing to respond to a Department request for information in a timely manner.

Anita Dewan, West Frankfort – physician and surgeon license (036-061456) reprimanded for failing to read a lab report after a pap smear because her staff accidentally filed the report in the patient's chart before Dr. Dewan saw it. As a result of failing to see the report, the patient was not advised of the need for a repeat pap smear which might have led to an earlier diagnosis of cancer.

Christopher Graviss, Richmond Heights, MO – physician and surgeon license (036-085725) reprimanded for allegedly failing to accurately read a mammogram and initiate additional follow-up on patient examinations, and fined \$4,500 for failing to reply to a department request for information in a timely manner.

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Kathleen A. Gross, St. Joseph, MI – physician and surgeon license (036-082509) indefinitely suspended after being disciplined in Michigan.

Anil Gupta, Mount Vernon – physician and surgeon license (036-065878) placed on indefinite probation, and controlled substance license indefinitely suspended, for the habitual use of drugs and due to a criminal conviction for making false statements to federal agents.

Keith Hauser, Burbank – chiropractor license (038-004967) indefinitely suspended for billing an insurance company for services that were not rendered.

Less than two weeks earlier, Dr. Riseman ordered the same dosage of oral laxative for another infant patient who became dehydrated, but recovered. The Department also alleges Dr. Riseman performed unnecessary surgical procedures on an infant patient he was treating for Hirschprung's disease, failed to properly perform a breast biopsy which resulted in the patient having to undergo a second biopsy, failed to properly diagnose and treat infant patients resulting in injury or death and failed to inform parents he is not a pediatric surgeon.

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Itai T. Rozovsky, Cherry Hill, NJ – physician and surgeon license (036-083229) reprimanded for allegedly failing to notify the Department that he was terminated from the Medical Assistance Program.

Carlos Rucci, Oak Brook – physician and surgeon license (036-044044) reprimanded for failing to properly document time authorization requests when seeing patients in his private practice.

James Runke, Chicago – physician and surgeon license (036-072041) reprimanded and fined \$10,000 for practicing on a non-renewed license for approximately 15 months.
