**Springfield, Illinois** – Leonard A. Sherman, Director of the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation, announced the following disciplinary actions taken by the Department during the month of **April 2002**.

**ARCHITECTS, LAND SURVEYORS, PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS  
AND STRUCTURAL ENGINEERS**

**Atif Galal Ahmed, Peoria** – professional engineer license (062-054402) revoked for submitting licensure applications and employment applications which contained misrepresentations, falsifying his experience, using education credentials that could not be verified or authenticated, and holding himself out as an engineer prior to becoming licensed.

**BARBER, COSMETOLOGY, ESTHETICS AND NAIL TECHNOLOGY**

**Chicago Style II Salon, Romeoville** – salon license (189-006058) reprimanded and fined \$600 for allowing four unlicensed individuals to practice as cosmetologists.
