

**ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF PROFESSIONAL REGULATION
DISCIPLINARY REPORT FOR DECEMBER 2002**

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Springfield, Illinois – Robert E. Hewson, Jr., Acting Director of the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation, announced the following disciplinary actions taken by the Department during the month of **December 2002**.

ACCOUNTANT

Ira S. Becker, Chicago – public accountant license (065-007781) reprimanded for failing to provide trust and personal records of the deceased to a beneficiary, failing to provide timely accountings as required by the trust, and failing to file tax returns for 1999 and 2000, while he was trustee for a trust created by a client's will.

George J. Modzelewski, Chicago – public accountant license (065-021405) reprimanded and fined \$7,000 for directing his employees to attend continuing education classes and sign his name to the attendance lists, failing to comply with reporting standards of Generally Accepted Auditing Standards (GAAS) in an audit report on financial statements he prepared for a company, and submitting audit working papers which failed to comply with fieldwork standards of GAAS. Auditor reports were also submitted on the letterhead of an unlicensed public accounting firm.

John Quinn Mucker, Oak Lawn – public accountant license (065-010362) reprimanded and fined \$1,000 for failing to answer inquiries from a primary beneficiary, and failing to provide timely accountings, of an estate for which he was the executor and accountant.

Eugene C. Varnado, Dolton – public accountant license (065-009460) reprimanded for practicing under a name other than the full name as shown on his license or by a legally authorized name and failing to make a substantive response to a request for information from the Department within 30 days.
