**ARCHITECTS, LAND SURVEYORS, PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS

Electronic Architects, Mount Vernon; Kenneth B. Nelson, Mount Vernon; and, Van C. Bushue, Mount Vernon – ordered to cease and desist using the term “Architect” and from engaging in the unlicensed practice of professional engineering.

Edward C. Kerr, Palatine, and Kerr & Associates, Palatine – ordered to cease and desist from engaging in the unlicensed practice of professional engineering.

John Lupinos, Chicago – ordered to cease and desist the unlicensed practice of architecture.
