BANKS AND TRUSTS

Community Bank of Oak Park River Forest, Oak Park – consent order to stop engaging in unsafe and unsound banking practices.

The Leaders Bank, Oak Brook – consent order to stop engaging in unsafe and unsound banking practices.

RESIDENTIAL MORTGAGE

Bass Financial Corp., Glenview – residential mortgage license (MB.0006674) revoked for improper transfer of ownership and change in business activities.

Casement Mortgage Brokers, Inc., Elgin – residential mortgage license (MB.0006413) revoked and fined \$10,000 for failure to permit examination by the Department.

Hodz Financial Group, Inc., Chicago – residential mortgage license (MB.6760380) revoked and fined \$10,000 for failure to respond to supervisory and licensing requests, pay an examination fee, and document net worth.

Lifetime Financial Partners, Inc., Bloomington – residential mortgage license (MB.6759849) revoked and fined \$10,000 for failure to respond to supervisory requests, pay a fine, and provide financial statements.

Lynmar Lending Group, Inc., Naperville – residential mortgage license (MB.6760199) fined \$500 for failure to comply with advertising requirements.

Mortgage & Investments Consultants, Inc., St. Paul, MN – residential mortgage license (MB.6760437) revoked for failure to comply with Consent Order.

Trust One Mortgage Corporation, Oak Brook – residential mortgage license (MB.6759722) revoked per Consent Order.

United Mortgage Services, Addison – residential mortgage license (MB.6760020) fined \$500 for failure to comply with advertising requirements.

CONSUMER CREDIT

American General Financial Services of Illinois, Inc., Evansville, IN – CI License (109) fined \$1,000 for failure to contain evidence of a contract signed or acknowledged by the borrower.

Cottonwood Financial Illinois, LLC d/b/a The Cash Store, Irving, TX – CI License (3381) fined \$2,575 for the following violations: Title-secured lender did not obtain borrower's most recent income documentation available at the time the loan was made, repossession file did not indicate a statement of final accounting containing the required information was sent to the borrower, lender did not input accurate information into the database to determine if the obligor was eligible for a loan, lender did not properly update the database with the required information on the day the transaction or event occurred, paid contract was not properly dated, and an executed copy of paid contract or other legal document retained in file but not stamped "PAID IN FULL" or equivalent.

Great Lakes Specialty Finance, Inc., d/b/a Check 'n Go, Cincinnati, OH – PL License (1126) fined \$2,550 for the following violations: Lender did not input accurate information into the database to determine if the obligor was eligible for a loan, official income documentation was not the required type for a payday loan or was not for the 30 days preceding the loan, and an executed copy of paid contract or other legal document retained in file but not stamped "PAID IN FULL" or equivalent.

Great Lakes Specialty Finance, Inc., d/b/a Check n' Go, Cincinnati, OH – PL License (1094) fined \$17,475 for the following violations: The loan document or other legal instrument contains blanks, Original documents, or approved equivalent, not cancelled or returned following payoff, lender did not input accurate information into the database to determine if the obligor was eligible for a loan, lender did not verify that the loan was permissible., Lender did not obtain any official documentation of the borrower's income before making a payday or title secured loan, upon receipt of a check from a consumer for a loan, the lender did not immediately stamp the back of the check with an endorsement that states: " This check is being negotiated as part of a loan under the Payday Loan reform Act.", lender made a payday loan resulting in the borrower having combined outstanding payday loan principle balances greater than 25% of borrower's gross income, file did not contain evidence of contract signed or acknowledged by the borrower, lender did not obtain any official documentation of the borrower's income before making a payday or title secured loan, lender did not verify that the loan was permissible, lender did not input accurate information into the database to determine if cancelled or returned following payoff, the loan document or other legal instrument contained blanks, and an executed copy of paid contract or other legal document was not stamped "PAID IN FULL" or equivalent.

Great Lakes Specialty Finance, Inc., d/b/a Check n' Go, Cincinnati, OH – CI License (3038) fined \$2,350 for the following violations: The loan document or other legal instrument contained blanks, original documents, or approved equivalent, not cancelled or returned following payoff, evidence of a signed or acknowledged Truth-in Lending Disclosure was not in the file of original papers, and an executed copy of a paid contract or other legal document retained in file but not stamped “PAID IN FULL” or equivalent.

Lighthouse Financial Group of IL, Inc., Tampa, FL – CI License (2223) fined \$7,575 for the following violations: Lender made title-secured loans with a scheduled monthly payment exceeding 50% of the obligor's gross monthly income, title-secured lender did not obtain borrower's most recent income documentation available at the time the loan was made, licensee disposed of collateral during the redemption period, lender did not input accurate information into the database to determine if the obligor was eligible for a loan, lender did not enter into the database the borrowers loan was paid in full or cancelled on the day the transaction was made, lender did not obtain any official documentation of the borrower's income before making a payday or title-secured loan, and wage assignment was accepted from the borrower that contained blank spaces.

QC Financial Services, Inc., Overland Park, KS – CI License (2586) fined \$13,025 for the following violations: Acts and rules are not in the permanent file, improper simple interest calculations, and title-secured loan is not fully amortized or is not repayable in substantially equal installments.

QC Financial Services, Inc., Overland Park, KS – CI License (2248) fined \$2,200 for the following violations: Improper simple interest calculations, security was not properly disclosed, and the title-secured loan agreement did not prominently disclose DFI's address and phone number and advise the borrower of the right to report lending and collection violations.

Quick Cash of Illinois, Inc., Jerseyville – CI License (2628) fined \$2,575 for the following violations: Keys are retained by the lender on the title-secured loan or motor vehicle retail contract, but it is not provided for in the loan contract, title-secured lender did not obtain borrower's most recent income documentation available at the time the loan was made, and lender did not input accurate information into the database to determine if the obligor was eligible for a loan.

Riverside Finance, Inc., Red Wing, MN – CI License (2776) fined \$1,750 for the following violations: Licensee did not properly maintain loan records for two years after the final entry, security was not properly disclosed, and security was not properly released.

The Payday Loan Store of Illinois, Inc., Chicago – PL License (1313) fined \$2,175 for the following violations: Lender did not input accurate information into the database to determine if the obligor was eligible for a loan, lender did not enter into database that the borrower's loan was paid in full or cancelled on the day the transaction was made, lender made a payday loan resulting in the borrower having a combined outstanding payday loan principle balance greater than 25% of the borrowers income, and paid contract was not properly dated.

The Payday Loan Store of Illinois, Inc., Chicago – CI License (1701) fined \$13,750 for the following violations: Acts and Rules are not in the permanent file, the loan document or other legal instrument contained blanks, security was not properly disclosed, licensee did not disclose on delinquency notices for title-secured loans the availability of debt management information at DFI's toll-free number, licensee did not deliver or mail to the borrowers affidavit of defense,

repossession file did not indicate a statement of final accounting containing the required information was sent to the borrower, lender did not have established control policies to ensure privacy of applicants' and borrowers' financial information, paid contract is not properly dated.

Title lenders, Inc., D/B/A USA Payday Loans, Deerfield – CI License (2202) fined \$3,250 for the following violations: Improper simple interest calculation and interest rebate is insufficient.

Title Max of Illinois, Inc., Savannah, GA – CI License (3304) fined \$1,000 for failure to input accurate information into the database to determine if obligor was eligible for a loan.

Tower Loans of Illinois, Inc., Shawnee, OK – CI License (2956) fined \$68,025 for the following violations: Licensed location did not prominently display the license or renewal certificate, Lender made or purchased loans without the required license, Lender did not have established control policies to ensure privacy of applicants' and borrowers' financial information.

US Water Company, Cedar Rapids, IA – SF License (1317) fined \$1,600 for the following violations: Licensee moved without 10 day notice or the applicable preapproval from the director, the loan document or other legal instrument contains blanks, the Loan contract did not accurately disclose the schedule of payments or the total of payments, and file did not contain evidence of a contract signed or acknowledged by the borrower.

Wink Development LLC d/b/a Cash express of Olney, Claremont – CI License (2803) fined \$1,050 for the following violations: Documentation is not in file to indicate lien release or title was returned to borrower on a title-secured loan within 24 hours or 5 days if paid by check and lender did not properly enter loan(s) into database on the day made.

New Mt. Greenwood Currency Exchange, Inc., Chicago – Currency Exchange License (3252) fined \$2,550 for failure to maintain the statutorily required minimum net worth.
