

CERTIFICATION OF PHARMACY INTERN HOURS FROM ILLINOIS TO ANOTHER STATE:

- Must hold an active Illinois Pharmacy Technician license at the time hours were completed.
- Must furnish a letter from your supervising pharmacist in Illinois on letterhead stationery stating the starting date and the ending date of employment and the **total** number of hours worked. The supervising pharmacist then must sign and date this statement. **Check stubs are not acceptable.** If you just graduated from College, furnish a letter from a Dean or Professor on letterhead stationery stating the **total** number of hours of practical training completed. **Your Social Security Number must also be included in the letter.** Also indicate in your letter which State you would like the letter to be sent to.
