ORDER ASSESSING FINE

Pursuant to Sections 7-1 of the Residential Mortgage License Act of 1987 (the “Act”)[205 ILCS 635/ 7-1] and Section 1050.2170 of the rules promulgated thereunder (the “Rules”) [38 Ill. Adm. Code 1050.2170], a fine of \$1,500.00 is imposed against Jonathon Saxon (Expired Registration No. 031.0006146; “Registrant”),

This fine will be imposed for conducting loan origination activities without being duly registered by the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation Division of Banking. That Registrant’s registration expired due to his untimely renewal which led Registrant to place a new application for loan originator Registration with the Department. That issues arose from said new application which prompted an interview with Registrant to discuss his qualifications. Through the interview process Registrant admitted and provided evidence that he had originated several loans for the company he was sponsored by in his current application to be a loan originator.
