**FINAL ORDER**

NOW COMES the Director of the Division of Banking of the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois having received the record in this matter, entitled the Administrative Law Judge’s Report and Recommendation (the “ALJ Report”), I provide the following background, make findings of fact and conclusions of law, and order as set forth below.

**BACKGROUND**

1. This matter comes before me upon the ALJ Report dated March 13, 2018.
2. On April 3, 2017 the Department issued an Order denying the Mortgage Loan Originator license application of Anthony Volz, pursuant to Section 7-3(2)(B) of the Residential Mortgage License Act of 1987 (“Act”).

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

3. The ALJ Report provided 4 paragraphs of proposed findings of fact and are adopted herein by reference the aforementioned findings as my findings of fact.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

4. I adopt the Administrative Law Judge's proposed conclusions of law.

**RECOMMENDATION**

5. I adopt the Administrative Law Judge's proposed recommendation.

- I. The Mortgage Loan Origination license application of Anthony Volz is DENIED.
- II. Costs of hearing shall be assessed pursuant to Section 1050.1790 of the Rules of the Residential Mortgage License Act of 1987 [38 Ill. Adm. Code 1050.1790].
